Upon completion of the course, the participants will have profound knowledge of the different general and specific hazards in ports and terminal operations, good understanding on how to react to chemical spills, and understand the setting up of procedures and implementations of safety systems. The Course is in accordance with IMO Model Course 1.10.

- Relevant Chemistry;
- Definitions and Classification;
- Personal Protection;
- Safety Requirements;
- Documentation;
- Packaging and Handling;
- (International) Legislation for Transport and Storage;
- Cleaning Waste and Spillage;
- Leakage Repair;
- Fire Fighting Theory.
